Traditional Approaches

Purchasing and start up are more complex

The traditional process takes up to six weeks, from selecting and ordering hardware and software to set-up and testing. In addition, companies that outsource their IT functions typically incur significant costs for consulting and setup.

Installation takes more time (average 120 hours)

You're on your own with set up:

1. Unpack computers.
2. Set up each computer and plug in all peripherals (monitor, keyboard, mouse, etc.).
3. Load software on all workstations.
4. Set up server and load software.
5. Set up network.
6. Test networking and configure printers, Internet, etc.

Manual intervention is required

If problems do occur, you'll need to find a computer consultant to visit your office and diagnose and fix problems, or you'll have to sit on the phone with the computer support, often located in India. Your problem could take days – or even weeks – to solve.

Complicated "fixes" for computer problems

Currently if your computer fails, you will need to call someone to diagnose the problem. If there is any data on the computer, you will need to restore from backups, if you did indeed back up your data.

Replacing the broken system takes time

1. If the computer is under warranty, you can ship the whole system back (at your expense), wait several days to a week for a diagnosis of the problem and then get a replacement.
2. The replacement will not have your software loaded; you must reload the software, hook the computer back up to your network, and configure it.

Your Data is at Risk

You will always need to remember to back up your data. You'll also need to purchase additional hardware to store your data.

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
